

During this rating period Burglary (Residential/

Business) has become a problem in our area. Overall our crime is down all around the board but residential burglaries are occurring during day-watch hours. In several of the burglaries the suspects forced open the rear door or window at location to avoid anyone observing them committing their crime. The suspects removed hand held carry items for a quick get away. Install additional locks to the rear doors and windows. Be a good neighbor, if you observe your fellow neighbor being victimized, call the

police right away with a good description of the suspects. Join your local Neighborhood Watch Group or start one. It is still the best weapon we have against crime.

Neighborhood Safety Tip

Neighborhood Watch works by showing residents they are not powerless against crime. By using crimeprevention training, victim assistance and phone trees, neighborhoods can help erase crime and gang violence from their communities.
