What is a senior lead officer?

A senior lead officer (SLO) is an officer in charge of a basic car area within a geographic division. SLOs provide a link that help unite the LAPD with the communities it serves. They are responsible for monitoring crime trends in basic car areas, working with Community-Police Advisory Boards and acting as liaisons with detectives to stay informed of crime trends and special problems within their area. The SLO is often the main liaison for problem solving between the Department and the resident. Continuous interaction between the police and local residents is essential to enhancing the quality of life and deter crime within the neighborhood.

CRIME ALERT Phony Security Patrol Spotted in North Westdale

A neighbor on the 2500 block of Coolidge Avenue has reported that on January 29 in the late afternoon, a member of her household encountered a fake Bel-Air Patrol security guard. The man had parked a car with Bel-Air Patrol markings in front of the house and was picking up a package that had been left by UPS. Upon seeing the resident, the man handed back the package and said, "Oh, you're home. I was just getting ready to send this to the dispatcher for you."

The man, described as a middle-aged Hispanic male, was not wearing a Bel-Air Patrol uniform, but had on a black jacket that had "Security" lettered across the back. The phone number on the car he was driving turned out to be a disconnected number. ADT, the parent company of Bel-Air Patrol, has been notified about this incident and they are investigating it as of this writing.

Since nothing was stolen and the man had left the area, the police were not able to do anything further. Neighbors are encouraged to contact LAPD dispatch immediately at 877-275-5273 (ASK-LAPD) to report any suspicious activity.

Please note that Security Service Systems has a dedicated patrol car that does occasionally drive through North Westdale while they are patrolling Mar Vista and Hilltop. Residents who subscribe to their service may have the Security Service Systems patrolman check on their house several times a day while out of town. Currently North Westdale does not have enough subscribers to support a full-time patrol, but if you are interested in subscribing to the service, call (310) 477-2095


