Are You Ready For The Big One?

In an article earlier this year, The Los Angeles Times reported that Southern California was more likely to experience a major earthquake than Northern California. A report by the U.S.

California. A report by the U.S. Geological Survey predicted that the chance of a 6.7 magnitude temblor (equal to the Northridge earthquake of 1994) happening in Southern California within the next 30 years was 97%!

If you do not feel prepared for a natural disaster of this size, you are not alone. One way, you can better prepare yourself is by taking the L.A. Fire Department's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training. The class is FREE and there are no obligations associated with taking the training. You will learn what to do in major emergencies like earthquake or fire, plus skills like triage and search and rescue so that you

can better take care of your friends and family. The bottom line is, in a major disaster, emergency services will be too

> overwhelmed assessing damage to the city as a whole to respond to individual needs for at least several hours.

During this rating period Burglary/Theft from Motor Vehicle (BFMV) has become a problem in Basic Car 14A25 area. The majorities of the incidents

this period were smash and grab crimes. We must be more cognizant of our surroundings, suspects are smashing windows and removing property at all times during the day. STOP leaving items of value inside vour vehicle in plain sight; it is an open invitation for a BFMV suspect. Attempt to park in well lit areas with high pedestrian traffic. If you observe any suspicious activity be a good neighborhood and call the police right away. Join your local Neighborhood Watch Group it is still the best tool we have against crime.

Safety Tip: If you smell or see smoke/ fire, get out of the building quickly, and then call the fire department. Before opening any door during a fire, feel it with your back of your hand. If the door is hot, go to another exit. If the door is cool, kneel down and check the air coming in underneath the door. If the air is cool the room is safe to enter.

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
