Let's Keep It Clean

Judging by the old mattresses and furniture lining the alleys, many of us have been

cleaning our garages this fall. But you don't have to look for a place to dump those discarded items. The city will collect them for free if you are a regular customer of the Bureau of Sanitation. Call the Service Request Call Center to schedule a bulky-item pickup. The number is 800-773-2489, and the office is open Monday through Friday, 7:30 am - 4:45 pm.

For excess yard trimmings, the City offers a once a year collection free of charge to all households served by the Bureau of Sanitation. Trimmings must be bundled and tied, no longer than 4 feet long, and no heavier than 30 pounds. Call the Service Request Call Center at 1-800-773-2489 to schedule a collection.

What to do with that old computer or television set? Take it to the new UCLA S.A.F.E. Collection Center on Saturdays, 8 am – 2 pm. They also accept hazardous waste such as paint, cleaning products, garden and pool chemicals, automotive fluids, and batteries. The address is 550 Charles E. Young Drive West.

To dispose of an old bicycle that doesn't run any more, donate it to the Bike Out Recyclery at 2811 Pico Blvd (near the 99 Cent store.) Bike Out is a non-profit organization that repairs and re-sells bicycles to support youth programs. For more information or to schedule a pickup, call 310-453-5040.

To control shopping cart losses, the California Grocers Association formed the California Shopping Cart Retrieval Corporation (CSCRC), which now collects carts all over southern California. It has a contract with the city of L.A. for pickup in our area. To have an abandoned cart picked up, call CSCRC at 1-800-252-4613.
