and that the LAPD have already and will continue to prioritize the safety of neighborhood.

Also at the meeting, we decided to formally create a Neighborhood Watch Program. Monthly Farmers Market Report

If you enjoy peaches, nectarines and pluots, you'll be glad to hear they will be available through October at the Mar Vista Farmers Market. Arnett Farms from Fresno will continue to have numerous different pluot varieties throughout the remainder of the season. They will also be bringing persimmons to the market this month: first the Fuyu variety followed by the Hachiya variety. Tenerelli Orchards may carry peaches well into November.

Ha's Farm is now carrying sweet Italian prunes and French prunes which are good for baking. The first Bartlett pears are out, sweet and juicy. You'll see their first crop of apples for this season: Fujis, Cameos and Empires.

Crime Trends

The following are the crime statistics representing 7/1/10 - 7/31/10:

During this rating period Burglary (Residential/ Business) has become a problem in 14A25 area. We reduced crime in several categories this period, but we must regain control in residential burglaries. Effective home security need not be costly, just a bit of common sense and energy can go a long way. Install window locks on all lower level windows for extra protection. Keep shrubs and hedges trimmed. This will give intruders fewer places to hide while they commit their crimes. Place gravel beds below windows. Gravel can be noisy and tough to sneak across.
