Notes for NWNA Traffic Strategy Meeting #2 - July 11, 2016 - by Joan Winters - Attendance: 12 Welcome and a brief recap of last month's meeting. Chair, Helen Chin, asked for a volunteer to take notes. I volunteered to take the meeting's notes. Introductions and concerns were given. Some brought printed material from websites regarding traffic articles for all to review. example: StopSpeeders.org (speed signs).

Ideas for possible solutions mentioned included mobile speed notification signs, parking permits, speed bumps, approaching Councilmember Mike Bonin's office and the MVCC Traffic Committee.

Helen spoke about Safe Routes to School Program: She suggested liaisons to local schools, such as Richland Elementary, St. Joan of Arc, and Daniel Webster Middle School regarding cut-through traffic affecting routes to-and-from school. She also suggested that work groups could be formed based on specific NWNA neighborhood areas--those with similar traffic problem concerns.

A neighbor on Federal Ave., directly across from Richland Elementary, brought up the school's parkway and street issues, including the long-overdue needed trimming of the large trees near the auditorium.

Cut-through streets mentioned by attendees included: Amherst and Pearl, National and Burkshire, Barrington to Richland, Federal, (Richland Ave. to Brookhaven) Armacost (Sardis) to National, Armacost to Ocean Park Blvd., Wellesley and Pearl, Wellesley to Ocean Park Blvd., Burkshire-Radio Dr. (it was mentioned that there aren't sidewalks on Radio), Ocean Park Blvd., turning to Stoner, Barry Ave. at Sardis getting cut-through from Barrington, going down Barry to Clarkson Rd., to Federal Ave., or continuing up Clarkson to Butler Ave., turning to National Blvd.
