Dear Neighbors,

As we celebrate Independence Day, it is important to keep in mind that setting off consumer fireworks is not only illegal in Los Angeles, but it is dangerous and also very traumatic for many, especially those who are sick. Our pets and wildlife are also traumatized by the blasts of fireworks. Fireworks pollute our already bad air. I feel it is important to draw attention to these important facts that can be overlooked. Please report to the police if you see illegal fireworks.

Citing a growing number of reports of illegal fireworks being set off around the Fourth of July and other holidays, the Los Angeles City Council approved some strategies aimed at cracking down on the use of

pyrotechnics. Although fireworks are illegal in Los Angeles, every year in California they cause serious injuries and fires, and their use has become more widespread. On an 11-0 vote, the council directed the police and fire departments to implement a number of new strategies, including public outreach efforts bringing attention to the dangers of using illegal fireworks, and instructing the fire department to report on what steps are necessary to enable mobile reporting of violators through the 311 app or phone service. Councilman Mitch O'Farrell, who introduced the motion, said the problem of illegal fireworks appears to be growing. "This is a really, really serious and growing problem and has been for a long time, but it seems to have reached a crescendo last Fourth of July..."

The crime report below shows a drop in crimes since the last report. Please take note of Officer Acosta's reminders for us as we enter the hotter summer months.

At their last Board Of Directors meeting, the Mar Vista Community Council passed the motion in support of the Pelton's appeal to the L.A. City Council regarding the National/Barrington development traffic analysis. The appeal will next be heard at the L.A. Transportation Committee. Contact me for information.
