### **Monthly Farmers Market Report**

One of the highlights of summer is the weekly treasure of peaches from Summer Harvest Farms. The orchard owner John expects the taste and flavor of this summer's peaches to be similar to last year's high quality. An interesting note is that his orchards have hundreds of varieties of peaches, each reaching its peak at different times of the growing season. If you find a peach you like, get the name of the variety and buy lots of it since it may be available for only a few weeks before the next variety matures and is brought to the market.

EnFuso aged balsamic vinegars will make a great addition to your pantry. With their syrupy consistency from the aging process, a little will go a long way. Try it drizzled over grilled eggplant, zucchini and bell peppers. It would make a wonderful salad dressing (2 parts olive oil to 1 part balsamic vinegar) or added to a caprese salad (tomatoes, mozzarella and basil). It can even be used as a sauce over fresh fruit and vanilla ice cream. EnFuso is at the Mar Vista Farmers Market on the fourth Sunday of each month. enFuso.com.

#### **Crime Trends**

During this rating period Basic Car 14A25 has experienced an increase in Theft (Petty). Overall crime has decreased in our area across the board, but we still have some work to do. Petty theft is taking of property without the owner's consent. Teach family members to place items of value out of sight, such as toys and tools. Lock and secure all storage bins, tool sheds and garages. Most petty thefts are crimes of opportunity. Locking up items of value helps deter that opportunity. Join your local Neighborhood Watch Program, it is still the best tool against crime. If you observe any suspicious or criminal activities call the police right away.
