
Keeping an eye open for more than crime. By Joan Rubin

It was 5:30 on a Saturday afternoon and we were on a walk along National Blvd. going north towards Butler Ave., when I noticed that the fairly-new sidewalk was dramatically lifted and cracked since I walked by it just the day before. The huge Italian stone pine tree was leaning into the cables, putting stress on the telephone pole. The threat of it falling over alarmed us to call our L.A. Councilman Bill Rosendahl. Fate would have it that Bill was close by and he came right over in just a few minutes. He observed the tree and immediately made phone calls that

definitely activated the process of getting this emergency situation taken care of. We are all so fortunate to have this wonderful man as our councilman. Normally, calling 311 is recommended, but in this case Councilman Rosendahl had crews arriving in less than 20 minutes. It's important to be aware of our surroundings and I am very glad that I happened to look down that afternoon and realize the threat to our public safety.
