They also offer packages with two or three of the varieties for you to try. They are selling dried bitter melon which can be made into a tea, which they claim has various health benefits.





Fight the Bite! Help Track West Nile Virus, Report Dead Birds and Squirrels

West Nile virus (WNV) is a mosquito-borne disease that was originally found in Africa and has spread throughout the United States.



WNV is most often contracted from infected mosquitoes. It is not spread through casual contact. WNV affects the central nervous system. While 80 percent of people who become infected with WNV will not show any symptoms, others will display symptoms which can include fever, headache, body aches, nausea, vomiting and swollen lymph glands or a skin rash. Symptoms last for just a few days up to several weeks. A very small number of people (less than 1%) may develop severe

illness which can include permanent neurological effects and death.



WNV causes more serious illnesses in the corvid birds, which includes crows, jays, ravens and magpies, and also tree squirrels.
