West Nile Virus Awareness

I wanted to reach out to raise awareness about West Nile Virus (WNV), spread by infected mosquitoes. Recently, a dead bird found in the North Westdale area of Sunset Park Way tested positive for WNV. Dr. Beeler at the Los Angeles Department for Public Health asked me to inform neighbors about things we can do. Be proactive; to cut down on the mosquito population, be on the lookout for standing water. Even a bottle cap full, if left for a week or more, can be a breeding ground. At risk are the very young and people over 60.

Avoid mosquito bites by avoiding being outside at dawn or dusk, wearing long sleeves or use a repellent. Fortunately, most people infected with WNV will have no symptoms.

About 1 in 5 people who are infected will develop a fever with other symptoms. Less than 1% of infected people develop a serious, sometimes fatal, neurological illness.

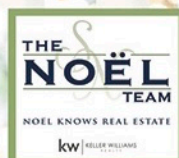
