Request from several neighbors to improve our neighborhood and to keep it clean and safe.

Please abide by the dogs-on-leash and dog-defecation laws (Los Angeles Municipal Code-sections 63.44 B2[d]&53.49), and the Los Angeles ban on the use of gas leaf blowers within 500 feet of a residence. (LAMC) Section 112. 04 (c)

At its March 9, 2015 meeting, the Mar Vista Community Council unanimously passed the following policy motion: All leaf blowers—whether powered by gas, electricity or battery—blow a mixture of fine particles into the air, particles that can go deep into the lungs. This mixture includes dust, fecal matter, pesticides, fungi, chemicals, fertilizers, spores, street dirt which can contain lead and gasoline, and anything else that happens to be in the vicinity of their use. Gas-fueled leaf blowers spew out additional air pollution in the form of unburned fossil fuel; one hour of use can create as much air pollution as a car driven for 100 miles. Los Angeles currently bans the use of gas leaf blowers within 500 feet of a residence due to noise—and not air—pollution. Many other cities have enacted leaf blower bans. Like Los Angeles, they have found the bans difficult to enforce. The Mar Vista Community Council requests enactment of a ban on the use of all types of leaf blowers at all City and Department of Water and Power controlled properties. In addition to being enforceable, this ban will • Reduce noise and air pollution. • Eliminate a health risk for anyone at or near the property— especially for those performing the landscape maintenance. • Allow the City and DWP to illustrate best practices and, thus, lead by example. MVCC further points out that grass clippings and fallen leaves are a source of soil-building organic matter and also help retain moisture, reducing the landscape's watering requirements.

Hello Neighbors,

Election: The current NWNA officers were unopposed and will continue to serve for another year. Your vote of confidence in our work is appreciated. Thank you.

LAPD Officer Adrian Acosta had to reschedule his visit to us and he will now be our guest speaker at our June 28 meeting at Saint Andrew's. Separately, a representative from Ring security doorbell emailed me just prior to our May 24 meeting that he could not attend. If you are interested in a Ring discount that they may offer, email me and I will keep you posted. On the plus side, this allowed Lenore French more time to present information about the Mar Vista Art Walk.

Santa Monica Airport (SMO)

Just a few days before the Santa Monica City Council would meet to decide how they would proceed in shortening the SMO runway, I learned that only two of four option designs presented to Santa Monica by AECOM consultants were publically vetted and considered by SM City Council. The two option designs that would move the runway farther west and would offer more relief to us here in North Westdale were not considered. I contacted our City Council and Congress Representatives to inform them about this. During public comment at the Council meeting, representatives from both the offices of Los Angeles City Councilmember Mike Bonin and Congresswoman Karen Bass commented that SMO also affects their constituents. SM City staff did not publicly present a runway reconfiguration that would have moved the landing strip west, away from Los Angeles neighborhoods. Jacqueline Hamilton, field officer for U.S. Rep. Karen Bass, whose district includes an area next to the airport, said the runway section adjacent to her district should be removed. "It does feel as though the residents outside the City of Santa Monica have been bearing some disproportionate impacts from the airport for a very long time," Hamilton said. She continued, "And it feels as though those impacts will continue to be disproportionate." Geoff Thompson, representing and speaking for Councilmember Bonin said, "SMO has long disproportionately impacted the City of LA residents through what I think is a concerted effort to shift noise and air pollution away from the City of Santa Monica." SM City Council voted unanimously for the option that would center the shortened runway on the existing runway, and they were silent about the two options not considered. The Mar Vista Community Council recently passed a motion to have the City of Los Angeles engage with Santa Monica officials in order to ensure that the concerns of the Los Angeles residents, who are negatively impacted by SMO aircraft operations, be given adequate consideration.

Your involvement with this issue, and also in our neighborhood association, is very important.




