
#### Introduction of the Santa Monica Airport Runway Shortening Project.

On April 25, Santa Monica City staff conducted an Airport Stakeholder Community meeting to discuss the two design options for shortening the runway at Santa Monica Airport. As you all know, the Consent Decree signed by the City of Santa Monica and the U.S. Government, permits the City to shorten the runway from its current 5,000 foot length to 3,500 feet. Although I saw many familiar faces among the 120+/- people in the audience today, I know not every one was able to attend.


Hence, for your information, for those who were unable to attend: On May 2, the Airport Commission will hear essentially the same presentation. The Airport Commission will take and consider public testimony regarding the design options prior to making its recommendation to the City Council. You are all welcome and encouraged to attend the Airport Commission meeting in order to express your preferred design option. The meeting will be at: 1685 Main

Street, Santa Monica, City Hall, City Council Chambers. The meeting starts at 7:00 pm. The City Council is tentatively scheduled to consider and select a design option on May 24th. Of course the City Council meeting will be held at City Hall. More information regarding that meeting as we get closer to the date.



Now in its second year, the Mar Vista Art Walk is a fun, FREE celebration of all the arts. Afraid of missing the NBA playoffs? No worry. The theme of the upcoming quarterly Mar Vista Art Walk (MVAW) is THE ART OF THE GAME and is all about the nature of healthy competition. Intended in its broadest interpretation, this runs the gambit from team sports, to mind games like chess, to internal competition (personal bars we establish for our own individual achievements – from physical expansion to mind expansion).

Use this as the perfect excuse to come and check out the new changes to Venice Blvd, likely to be completed by the June Art Walk. Mike Bonin's much-anticipated Venice Blvd., Great Street Pilot Project, is well underway and construction on the mid-block crosswalks at Mountain View Av, Ocean View Av., Boise and Stewart, the protected bike lanes and the reduction of auto traffic lanes from 6 down to 4, and Artwalk offers the perfect opportunity to look and see.

What makes this art walk unique is its emphasis on sidewalk engagement. Instead of indoor gallery hopping bound by 4 walls, visitors interact with artists,

musicians and poets everywhere -- on sidewalks, in alley parking lots and everywhere between.

Food (vegan options), indie bands, live street painting, film, art installations, emerging and established artists, dance and experimental video.




