


GUEST SPEAKER ARNIE CORLIN ON CRIME PREVENTION

Motion regarding Santa Monica Airport:

Vote at the October 15 Airport Committee meeting and the October 23 NWNA General meeting. The North Westdale Neighborhood Association (NWNA) supports turning Santa Monica Airport (SMO) into a great park. Over the past several years, the NWNA has been in support of California State legislation aimed at addressing the critical impacts of air pollution from SMO aircraft operations upon neighboring residents.

Arguably the most impacted neighbor of SMO, the NWNA believes that the replacement of SMO with a great park including lots of open space would not only solve the public health concerns that exist today, but would offer very much needed open space to the west-side Los Angeles and Santa Monica area. The NWNA strongly supports the "Airport to Park" effort and urges the City of Santa Monica, the City of Los Angeles, the County of Los Angeles, California State, and Federal legislatures as well as all appropriate Federal agencies and administrations to work toward that end.

The weather in Southern California and the Central Valley allows us to enjoy certain fruits and vegetables well into October and even November. Tenerelli Orchards expects to have peaches possibly past Thanksgiving with Last Chance and Autumn Lady varieties. These peaches will be crispier and tangier

than summer fruit. Heirloom tomatoes should continue to be available this month but will be susceptible to colder weather or rain. Also look for cooler weather vegetables such as kales, mustard greens, collard greens and winter squashes, such as spaghetti squash.

George Bliss Ranch is a fifth generation business specializing in certified organic haas (or hass) avocados. The microclimate of the orchard allows for the availability of avocados throughout the year. Ask Teddy Bliss the secrets to ripening a green avocado using a brown paper bag and a banana peel.
